Carlton & Gedling U3A hosted an event in February—25 U3As (71 people plus the C&G committee) came together to talk about Beacon. Tom Grainger, Chair of Carlton & Gedling opened the meeting, and then the first hour was spent in breakaway groups with Webmasters, Membership Secretaries, Treasurers and Group Co-ordinators each looking at Beacon from the perspective of the roles that they have. Whilst 50% of Nottinghamshire U3As are already on Beacon, those that are not were able to sit in on a demonstration of the system to judge the benefits for themselves.

A final feedback and Q&A session highlighted the varied and diverse ways that individual U3As organise themselves but everyone took away some new knowledge, made friends and contacts, and benefited in general from the buzz of the event. Jean Hogg, our Regional Trustee, closed the meeting.
