Stage three (no earlier than 17 May):

- People can meet in groups of up to 30 outdoors
- Six people or two households can meet indoors
- Pubs, restaurants and other hospitality venues can seat customers indoors
- Up to 30 people can attend weddings or other life events, like christenings
- Remaining outdoor entertainment, such as outdoor theatres and cinemas can open
- Indoor entertainment such as museums, theatres, cinemas and children's play areas can open
- Performances and large events can restart, but with limits on audience numbers
- Hotels, hostels and B&Bs can reopen
- International leisure travel may resume
- Adult indoor group sports and exercise classes can restart

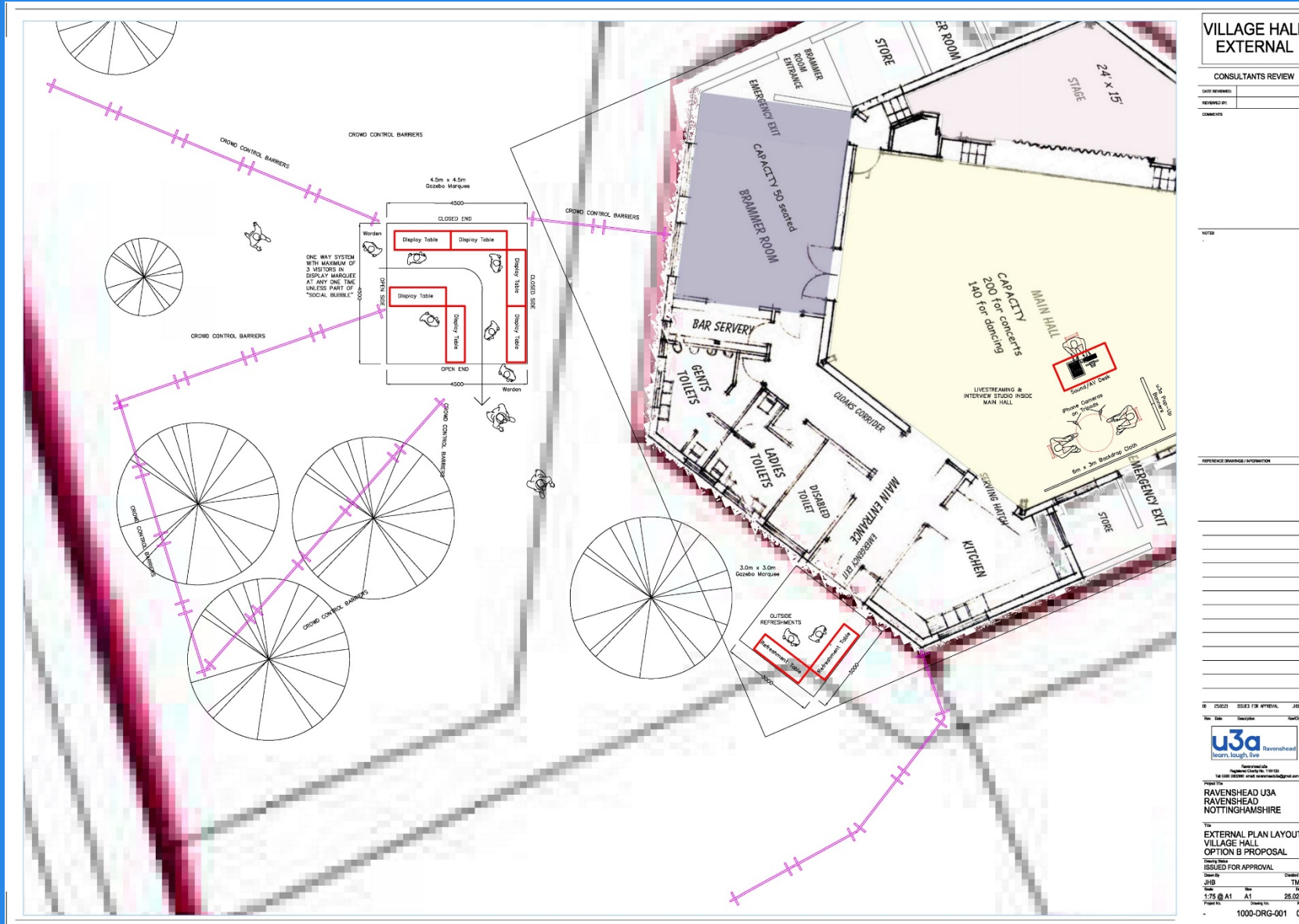

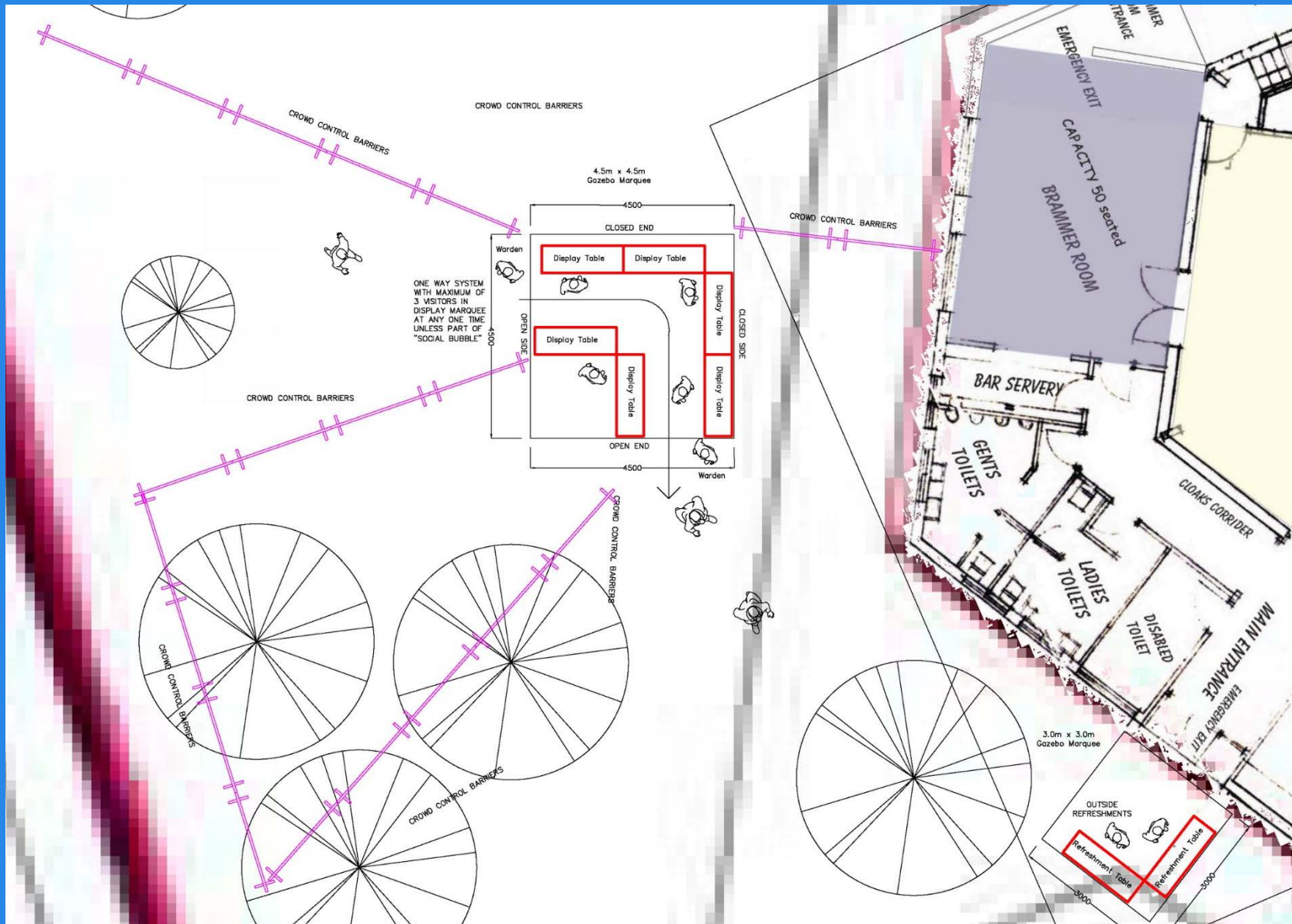

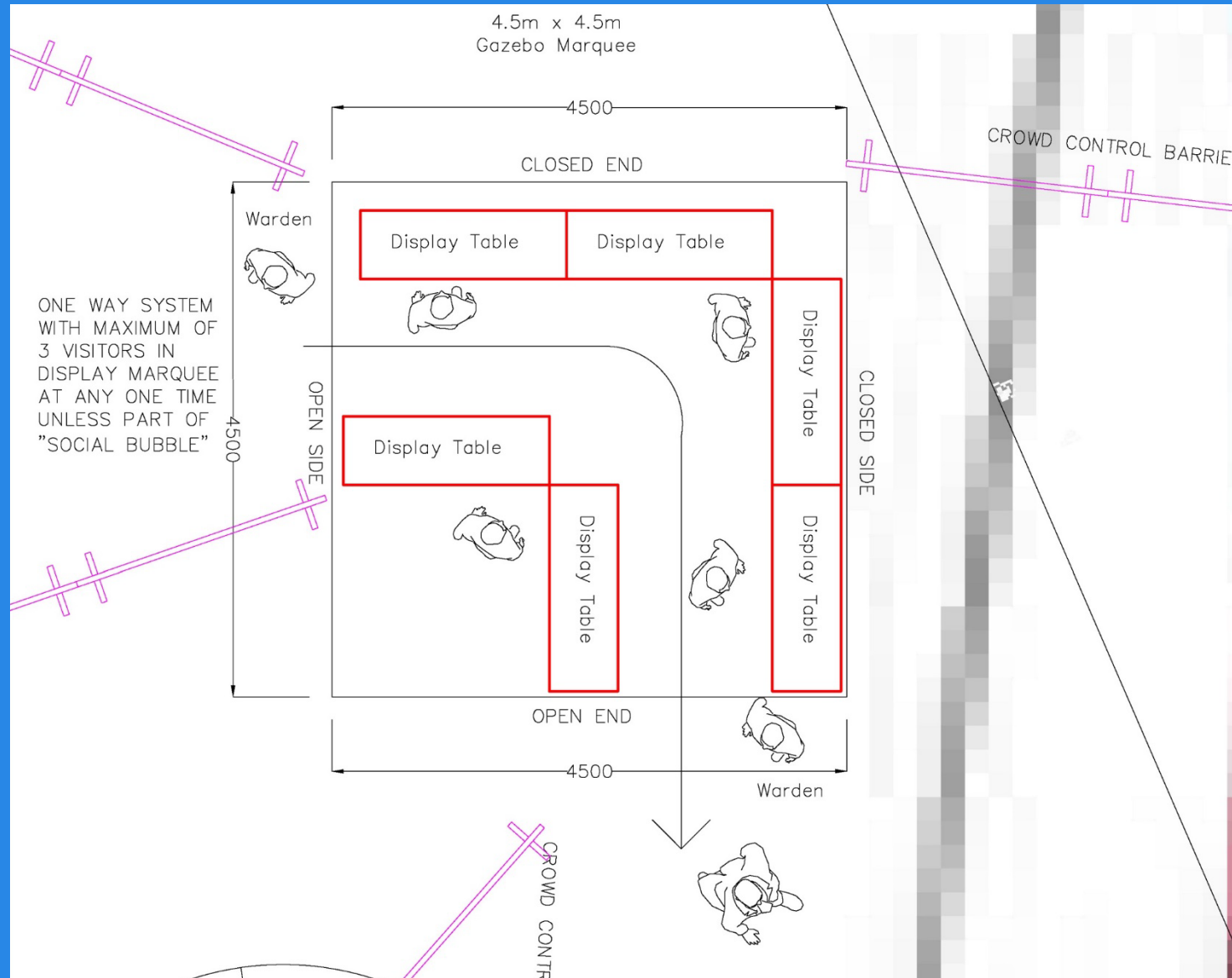
Control Measures

2. Four Warden volunteers to guide & police crowding
3. One Member in the Marquee to answer queries
4. Static Displays with no representation at tables
5. One way system with maximum of 3 visitors in Marquee
6. Access to Village Hall only for Catering & Interviews
7. 10 Volunteers & 20 visitors at any one time outside

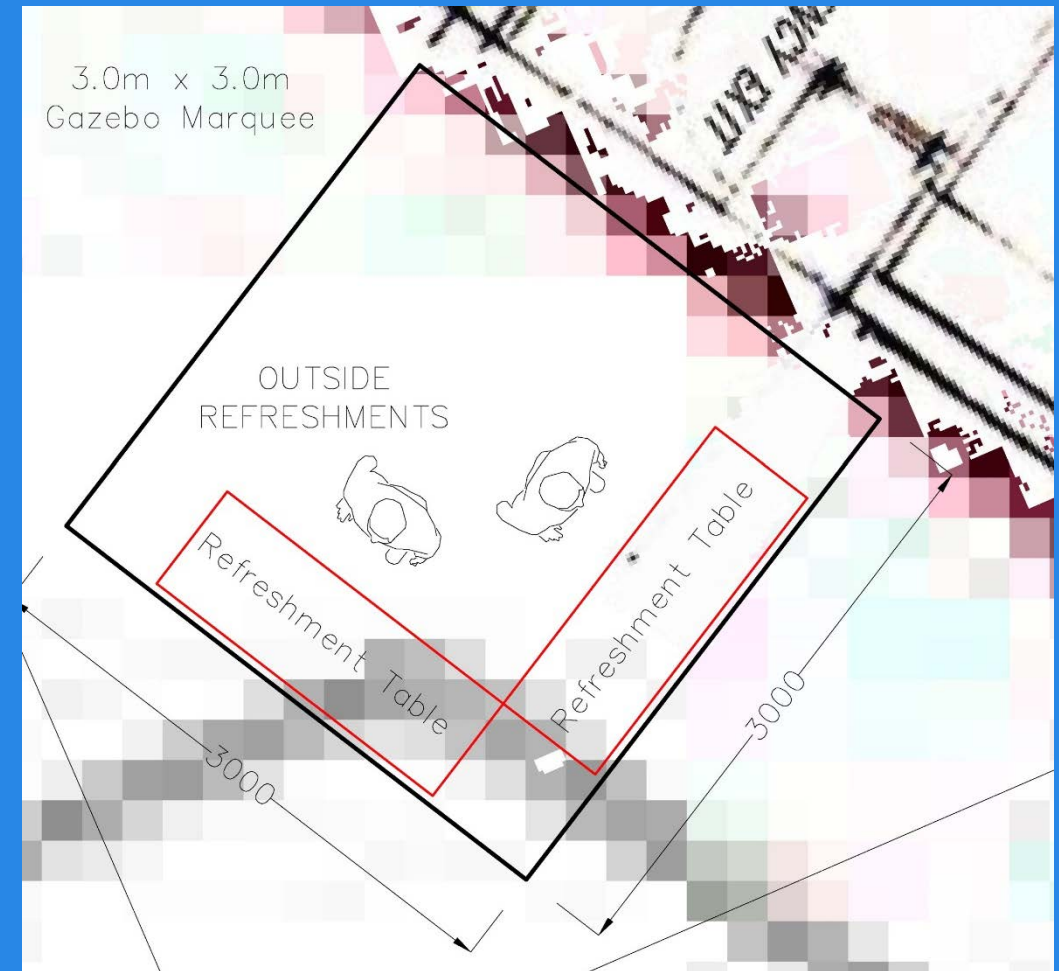
